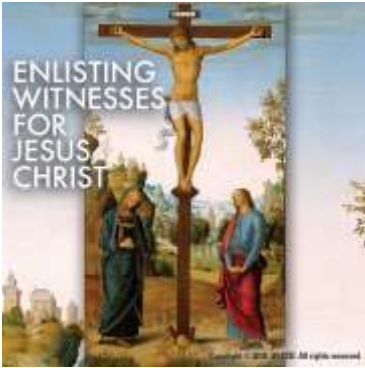

Catechetical Sunday September 16, 2018
